

3. Pregnancy, Child Birth and Child Raising (子どもを産んで育てるとき)

3-1 When you get pregnant (妊娠したら)

【Maternal and Child Health Handbook and medical exam vouchers】

(母子健康手帳と健診受診券つづり)

Please make sure you submit “Pregnancy Notification Form” at the Public Health Center (pp.16–17) in the ward where you live in order to receive “Maternal and Child Health Handbook” and “medical exam vouchers” (for 14 medical check-ups: designated check-up items are covered by Sakai City). Please bring your handbook and vouchers with you when you go to hospitals and Public Health Centers so that mother and baby’s health record will be written down. Maternal and Child Health Handbooks are available in nine languages (English, Korean, Chinese, Spanish, Portuguese, Vietnamese, Thai, Tagalog and Indonesian).

【Antenatal classes】 (妊婦教室)

Antenatal classes are held at Public Health Centers. Professional staff provide life guidance during pregnancy, preparation for birth, child raising, nutrition and dental health. Fathers can also participate.

3-2 When your baby is born (子どもが生まれたら)

【Notification of Birth】 (出生届)

Please submit Notification of Birth to the Civic Affairs Division in the Ward Office (pp.16–17)

【Medical subsidy system for infants and children】 (子ども医療費助成制度)

Subsidies for medical fees and hospital meal fees (standard co-payment charge) are provided to children from 0 years old to 18 years old (until the first March 31 after becoming 18 years old). (Only the fees covered by health insurance are eligible.) If you receive public assistance, you may not be eligible for the subsidies.

【Child Allowance】 (児童手当)

Child Allowance is provided to parents/guardians of children from 0 years old until the end of junior high school (the first March 31 after becoming 15 years old).

Inquiry Child-raising Support Division in the Ward Office (pp.16–17)

【Home visits to families with infants】 (乳幼児家庭全戸訪問)

Before your baby becomes four months old, nursery teachers, midwives or public health nurses will visit you to provide information regarding child care.

Please feel free to ask questions and raise concerns to the Child-raising Support Division in the Ward Office or Public Health Centers (pp.16–17).

【Health examinations for infants and vaccinations】 (乳幼児健診、予防接種他)

Health examinations, baby food classes and BCG vaccines are provided at Public Health Centers (pp.16–17).

Other vaccinations are provided in medical institutions in the City. Please check which vaccinations your baby needs to receive and when they are due in your Maternal and Child Health Handbook.

3-3 Child raising (子育て)
 【Daycares】 (保育)

【Child-raising support】 (子育て支援)

【School Expense Subsidies】 (就学援助)

Families with municipal primary and junior high school children (except special support education schools), who have financial difficulties sending their children can receive subsidies for school expenses such as stationery and primary school meals. (Means test required)

4. When you become a single parent (ひとり親家庭になったとき)

【Child-rearing Allowance】 (児童扶養手当)

Single parents or guardians (on behalf of parents) raising children up to the first March 31 after becoming 18 years old are eligible. (Income cap applies.)

Inquiry Child-raising Support Division in the Ward Office (pp.16-17)

【Daily support for single parent families, etc.】 (ひとり親家庭などへの日常生活支援)

Family life support staff dispatch service is available when single parents, widows or female divorcees living alone are having difficulties in carrying out house work temporarily due to illness, looking for a job, etc. Free of charge for the households receiving public assistance and/or those who are exempt from municipal tax.

Inquiry Child-raising Support Division in the Ward Office (pp.16-17)

【Medical subsidy system for single parent households】 (ひとり親家庭医療費助成制度)

A subsidy for medical fees (only the fees covered by health insurance is eligible) is provided to children up to the first March 31 after becoming 18 years old and to the father or mother of single parent households or child's guardians. (Income cap applies.)

If you receive public assistance, you may not be eligible for the subsidies.

【Other】 (その他)

You may be able to be given priority to live in public housing depending on your eligibility. Please ask for details below.
