

☆Wisteria in Ohama Park

Ohama Park is known for its wisteria. Within this park there are 3 areas with wisteria pergolas, and the wisteria that is north to a monkey breeding cage was planted around when Ohama Park was established in 1879, so it's over 140 years old. From late April, when the flowers start blooming, it produces clusters of white flowers around 25cm in length. There are 2 other wisteria pergolas with light purple-coloured flowers.

In 1937 azaleas were planted on this Water Filtration Plant for the public to enjoy, leading to them being widely loved and designated as the city's official flowering bush. Cancer Screening Test



The free screening tests for Sakai City residents are offered as part of the campaign to promote people to take them more often will be continued till March 31st, 2026. Let's get

checked regularly!

Cancer screening and target ages

Stomach cancer – even number ages *50 and over

Lung cancer – ages 40 and over Colorectal cancer – ages 40 and over Cervical cancer – women of even number ages *20 and over

Breast cancer – women of even number ages *40 and over

Stomach cancer risk check-up – once between ages 35-49

Prostate cancer – men of even number ages *50-69 (simultaneous implementation with stomach, lung or colorectal cancer screenings, or the specified health checkups for Sakai City National Health Insurance)

- *Those at an odd numbered age who didn't get tested the previous year are eligible for testing if they apply in advance at a Public Health center or Sakai City e-application system
- When you get tested, please bring a document that can confirm your identification (health insurance card or driver's license, etc.)
- All checkups available at individual medical institutions. Please make an appointment directly at a participating medical institution. For more details scan the QR code to visit the city's general health checkup (kenshin sogo) website (Japanese only).

****Tax Notice**

May will be the appointed time for payment for the light vehicle tax (portion by type) and also the start of the first appointed time for the fixed property and city planning taxes. The deadline is **June 2nd**. Please pay at the nearest banking facility, convenience store, by mobile apps such as Pay-easy or by credit card through the regional tax payment site (eLTAX). For those that use the automatic transfer, payment will automatically be deducted on **June 2nd** so please check that you have sufficient funds.

Only in the case of payment of the light vehicle tax (portion by type) by account transfer, a tax payment certificate for the vehicle model subject to vehicle inspection will be sent around mid-June for the continuation inspection

Furthermore, if you are taking a light vehicle inspection with either of the payment methods, the tax payment is linked to the 'light vehicle tax payment confirmation system (kei JNKS)', so you basically don't need to show a tax payment certificate at the counter when you receive your vehicle inspection.

X Follow the rules when constructing a building

When constructing a house or building, prior application must be made to receive confirmation from the city. In addition, depending on the area, buildings with certain purposes cannot be built, or any building may not be allowed to be built in the first place. When you want to construct a house or a building, please consult with a professional and adhere to the rules while planning.

Child-raising Support Division: Application for Child Allowance

Please beware of the following points if you are applying:

- when requesting a certificate or submitting a notification, you need documents to prove your identity (such as a driver's license, passport, health insurance card, etc.) and depending on the process a name seal (inkan) too.
- Depending on the contents of the notification or application, you may have to
 enquire with other municipalities or
 receive attachments from them so it may
 not be possible to complete the procedures on the day. Please enquire beforehand.
- You can issue documents such as a copy of your residence certificate, name seal (inkan) registration certificate, city or prefectural tax certificate at the convenience store using your My Number



Smoking and Littering Ban

In Sakai City, there is a ban on smoking and littering stretching from around Sakai Higashi station, the City Hall and Oshoji road to Sakai station (East to West). There is a 1,000 yen penalty fee if caught.

The areas of western Sakaihigashi station, Nakamozu station, Mikunigaoka station, JR Sakaishi station and the shopping arcade in front of it and Komyoike Station have been marked as priority areas for improvement. We appreciate your cooperation.

A Parking Ban-Zones for Bicycles & Mini Bikes

Each railway station in Sakai City (except for the Hankai Line) is designated as a parking ban zone. Bicycles and mini bikes left in the zone will be removed. In addition, we will collect the removal & storage fee for the re-

turn of a removed bike or mini bike. Please use the parking lot to park a bicycle or mini-bike.

Storing Water in Case of Disaster

It's important to store drinkable water for at least 7 days in case of a disaster. One person drinks about 3 liters of water for one day. It is necessary to save water in case of a large earthquake that could result in water pipes being damaged, causing filthy or sewage water not being properly disposed. If this happens, it is recommended that you refrain from using the water from the pipes. By doing this, you can reduce the sewage up to about
