

## Mozu Kofungun Exhibit Area

The Exhibit Area is adjacent to the rest area in the Sakai City Museum. It describes the major mounded tombs in the Mozu Kofungun, profiles the Mozu-Furuichi Kofungun, and provides information on World Heritage and the procedural flow for inscription on the list.

Through the windows, which look out on a glittering pond, visitors can enjoy the natural beauty of Daisen Park in all seasons.

#### Closed

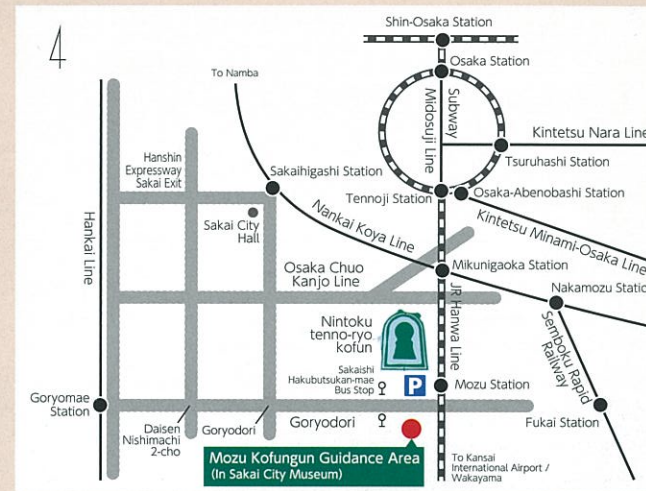
Mondays (except where a Monday is a public holiday) and during the year-end and New Year's holidays
