## 7 Cylindrical *haniwa* (replica)

This replica was produced based on historical artifacts excavated from Nintoku-tenno-ryo Kofun. It gives visitors a good idea of the huge size of the *haniwa* (stoneware funerary sculptures) placed on one of the world's largest tombs.

## 8 History of Nintoku-tenno-ryo Kofun - from ancient times to the present

A panel display shows how the appearance of this giant mounded tomb has changed since the time of its construction to the present.

#### Closed

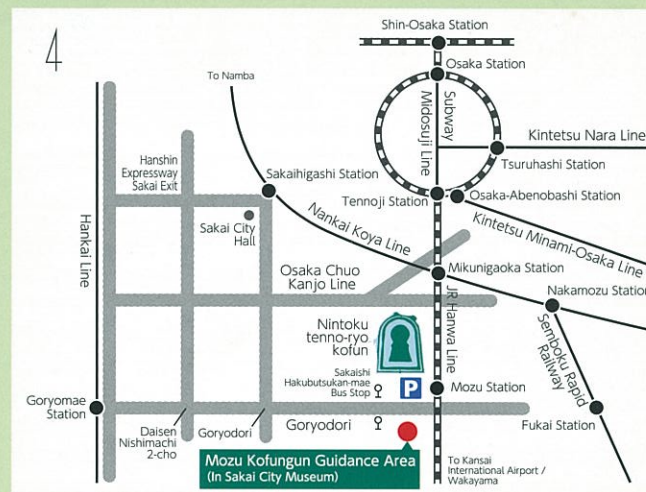
Mondays (except where a Monday is a public holiday) and during the year-end and New Year's holidays
