A preliminary examination slip with printed vaccination ticket is included in this envelope, so individuals who wish to get vaccinated should follow the procedures below to receive the vaccination. After receiving the shots, please keep the vaccination certificate in a safe place.

Outline of the first and second shots

Eligible persons Individuals aged 12 and over
 Type of vaccine Pfizer vaccine*
 Number of shots Two
 Time between shots Three weeks (2nd shot is generally given
 3 weeks after 1st shot)

*Depending on vaccine supplies, a non-Pfizer vaccine may be administered. Also, at vaccination sites outside the city it may be possible to receive a non-Pfizer vaccine.

Flow of vaccination

1 Check which medical institutions offer vaccinations and make an appointment.

- You can receive a vaccination in the municipality where your address is registered.
- An appointment is required to receive a vaccination. Please make an appointment to receive two doses of the same type of vaccine.
- To check which medical institutions are administering vaccinations, check the enclosed list of venues or visit the Sakai City website or the "COVID-19 Vaccine Navi" website run by the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare.

▼ Individual Vaccination Venues (Medical Institutions) Type of Vaccine: Pfizer

- Please apply directly to the medical institution where you wish to receive the vaccination.
- The period, date, time, and appointment method for receiving vaccination will vary depending on the medical institution.
- Those with underlying diseases and receiving regular treatment are recommended to receive vaccinations from their primary care doctor.

*Be aware that appointments cannot be made at City Hall, ward offices, or mass vaccination venues.

Receive a vaccination at the medical institution or venue where you have made an appointment on the appointment date and at the appointed time.

You must have the following three documents to get vaccinated.

What to bring on the day

- ① Preliminary examination slip with printed vaccination ticket (included with this announcement)
- ② Vaccination certificate (included with this announcement)
- ③ Your ID document (a driver's license, a health insurance card, etc.)

*Please bring your medicine notebook if you have one.

- If you feel unwell, please contact the medical institution or venue where you have made an appointment or the Sakai City Multilingual Call Center, and hold off on getting the shot.
- The shot is administered in the upper arm near the shoulder, so please wear clothing that allows exposure up to the shoulder. Also, be sure to wear a mask.
- As a general rule, individuals aged 12 to 15 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian to receive the vaccination. The vaccination will not be given without the legal guardian's signature on the preliminary examination slip.

The vaccination will not be given to you without your consent

- The vaccination will be offered only to those who have understood both its preventive effect against COVID-19 and its risk of adverse events and have made their own decision to receive a vaccination.
- If you are currently under treatment for some sort of disease or are afraid of receiving a vaccination due to health reasons, please consult your primary care doctor to determine whether you should receive the vaccination.

If you receive a vaccination in a location other than the municipality where your address is registered

- In the case where you live in a municipality where your address is not registered You may receive a vaccination in the municipality where you live. Please contact the municipality where you live.
- In the case where you wish to receive a vaccination at the medical institution where you are hospitalized Please contact the relevant medical institution or facility, or the facility where you live
- In the case where you wish to receive a vaccination at the medical institution where you are being treated Please contact the relevant medical institution, for an underlying disease

*Those with underlying diseases should consult their primary care doctor in advance.

If you move out of Sakai City a vaccination ticket must be reissued at the municipality of your new address

The vaccination ticket from Sakai City cannot be used if you have moved away from the city. Please have the municipality to which you moved issue you a new ticket.
