is Community Cycle?

An eco - friendly public transportation system in which people share bicycles and can borrow and return them at any Cycle Port in the city



How to Use

1. Registration

1. Application for use (fixed term use/one - day use)

Application is accepted at Station - front Cycle Ports and One - day User Card Counter (only for one - day use).

2. User card is issued.

3. User puts money on the card.



You can put money on your card with a card renewing machine or a fare adjustment machine at Cycle Ports.

2. To Borrow

Station - front Cycle Port

Station - front Cycle Port where the superintendent is stationed (5 ports in the city)



1. Conduct a safety check on the bicycle that you use

2. Pass your user card over the cardreader of the authentication machine at the gate.

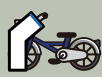
3. The lock of the gate is released.

4. Push the bicycle and go out through the gate.

5. Check the brakes and other conditions of the bicycle for safety and go!

Street Cycle Port

24 - hour available unstaffed rack - type Cycle Port (3 ports in the city)



※Electric bicycles are not rented at Street Cycle Ports.

2. Pass your user card over the card reader of the authentication machine to the left of the parking rack.

3. The lock is released when a blue lamp turns on.

4. Pull the bicycle out of the parking rack.

3. To Return

Station - front Cycle Port

1. Push the bicycle into the gate.

2. Now the bicycle is safely returned.



Street Cycle Port

※You cannot return electric bicycles to a Street Cycle Port.

1. Set the bicycle on the parking rack. (A blue light turns on)

Compliance with Traffic Rules



- Use bicycles in compliance with traffic rules and manners, yield to pedestrians, and always keep traffic safety in mind.
- A drunken person is prohibited to use Community Cycle.

Accidents and Other Troubles



- If you have trouble with the bicycle or lose its key, immediately report it to the Cycle Port(※) where you borrowed the bicycle.
 - If you have an accident concerning the bicycle or if it is stolen, immediately report it to the Cycle Port(※) where you rented it and to the police.
 - Take all due care when you use the bicycle because Sakai City will not bear any responsibility for any accidents that you are involved in while you are using it.
- (※)If you borrowed the bicycle at a Street Cycle Port, report to the Sakai - higashi Sta. Cycle Port.

Others



- When you return a bicycle to a Cycle Port, leave the bike unlocked.
- Whenever you park a bicycle outside a Cycle Port, park it in the designated parking space or other place where parking bicycle is permitted and make sure to lock it. Do not park your bicycle in an area where leaving bicycles is prohibited or where the parked bicycle can block traffic.
- Transferring a bicycle to another person is prohibited.
- You are required to pay an indemnity when the bicycle you are borrowing is stolen, damaged, or when its key or your card is lost.
- Please note that you cannot always borrow or return a bicycle at a Street Cycle Port, because the number of bicycle and rack is limited. When a Street Cycle Port is not available, go to another nearby Cycle Port.

Application for Use

- ◆ It takes 5 minutes to issue a user card.
- ◆ Bring your driver's license, student ID card, or other materials to verify your identity.



- ◆ Fill in the application form and submit it with your ID.

Conditions of use

Users must be junior high school students or above and able to ride a bicycle safely. (Those who live outside the city can also use the system.)

ID

Driver's license, health insurance card, student ID card, or other materials that verify your identification

Where and when the application is accepted

- The Superintendent's office of each Station - front Cycle Port (From 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.)
 - One - day User Card Counters (within the application hours of each counter)
- ※Application for fixed - term use is not accepted.

Note

Users must make the application procedure personally.

Available Hours

Fixed term use

Only ordinary bicycles (Electric bicycles are not available.)

- You can borrow and return a bicycle as many times as you want within the business hours of each Cycle Port.
- You can use a bicycle for two or more consecutive days but are required to return the bicycle every five days.
- You can renew your fixed - term user card from 10 days prior to the end of its term of validity.

One - day use

Bicycle ...Until 10:00 a.m. of the day following day of rent
Electric bicycle ...From 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

- You can borrow and return a bicycle as many times as you want within the rental period.
- You cannot extend the rental period of electric bicycle to the next day. Make sure to return the bicycle by 8:00 p.m. of the day of rent.
